

Co-Workers serve in tangible ways:

Handmaids:

be a support for a woman considering abortion- taking her out for tea, talking, checking in on her- helping to keep hope alive

Visitation Coordinator:

help coordinate resources in a community (arranging handmaids, etc)

Spiritual leaders:

priests and faith formators who are able to guide women offering spiritual support

Health professionals:

doctors/nurses committed to life who assist the woman during pregnancy and infant following birth

Visitation brothers:

MEN who approach the father of the baby with the heart of a brother mentoring and guiding him in learning to support mother and child

St. Josephs workers:

MEN willing to help by putting together cribs, moving furniture, etc.

College University Contacts:

:those involved in post- secondary education and campus life who can help with transfer of credits and tuition waivers

Business professionals:

someone who can advise/provide employment for a pregnant woman before/after giving birth

Counselors:

committed to upholding a woman's plans to give life to her child, provide essential supportive resource

Prayer guardians:

men or women who will stand spiritually lifting her up and guarding her through their prayers

All good things provider:

individuals/groups who will provide gift cards for maternity clothes, baby items, food

Holy Respite:

individuals/families who open their home to host a woman who is need of a place to stay during her pregnancy
