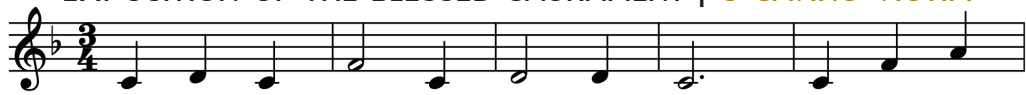


THE DIVINE PRAISES

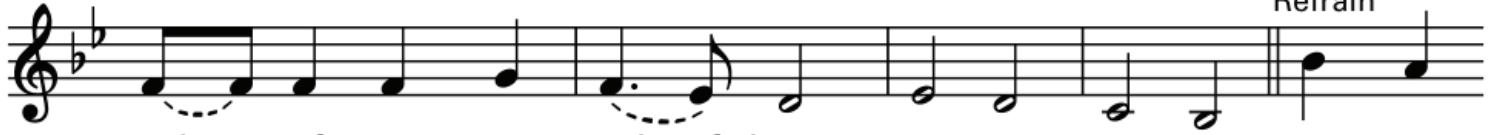
